



Public Transport



The **Trio Card** is one of the best options for getting around Liverpool by bus, train and ferry. It is a **prepaid travel card** that saves you carrying change and typically offers fares that are around 20% cheaper than cash single tickets.

If you only need one mode of transport, you can opt for a **bus-only** or **train-only** card instead of the full Trio Card. The **Merseytravel website** provides a variety of travel pass options, including weekly, monthly, and term-time passes to suit different needs and durations.

In Liverpool:



- **Royal Albert Dock**: historic waterfront with shops, museums and restaurants
- **Anfield Stadium**: home of Liverpool FC with guided tours and a museum for football fans
- **The Beatles Story**: museum dedicated to The Beatles' history and legacy
- **Liverpool Cathedral**: stunning architecture, and one of the largest cathedrals in the world!
- **Cavern Club**: iconic venue where The Beatles used to play
- **Liverpool ONE**: shopping and leisure complex
- **Lark Lane**: pretty area, ideal for a brunch or a coffee out of the city centre
- **Sefton Park**: large public park with a palm house and boating lake

- **Crosby Beach**: home to Antony Gormley's "Another Place" sculptures
- **Formby Beach**: sandy beach and red squirrel reserve
- **Southport**: seaside town with pier, gardens and arcades
