WHAT IS ERASMUS+?

Erasmus+ is the EU's programme to support education, training, youth and sport in Europe. As successor to Comenius, Grundtvig and Erasmus, Erasmus+ has taken over the funding of training for teachers in other European countries.

Full participation in the programme is open to all EU Member States as well as five non-EU Member States (North Macedonia, Iceland, Norway, Liechtenstein, Turkey).

LIFE, LANGUAGE & LITERATURE - A New ELT Methodology Course

COURSE DURATION: 2 WEEKS MINIMUM ENGLISH LEVEL: B2



This course is for practising teachers who wish to extend their knowledge of both Irish life and culture and contemporary English as it is used in Ireland. The course also increases participants' appreciation of different teaching techniques that can be used to bring Irish culture and literature into the English language classroom. The course at our school in Dublin, a UNESCO City of Literature, explores and promotes awareness of Anglo-Irish literature and some of the great Irish writers - Joyce, GB Shaw, Wilde, Kavanagh, Beckett - while also allowing you to explore Dublin's many obvious highlights and a few hidden treasures.

TECHNOLOGY IN THE CLASSROOM The Next Normal

COURSE DURATION: 2 WEEKS MINIMUM ENGLISH LEVEL: B2



After a year in which many teachers have been thrown in at the technology 'deep-end', this updated course allows practising teachers to draw breath and reflect on their experiences of using tech to teach English. We look at how we have been using various tools to teach during this past year, and what we can do to use them even more effectively. While we will still use a blend of presentation and demonstration of practical activities, throughout this course we will be working towards developing some shared principles for using (and not using) tech in the future.

GENERAL ENGLISH FLUENCY /FLUENCY PLUS

COURSE DATES: STARTING EVERY MONDAY MINIMUM ENGLISH LEVEL: A2



The General English Fluency course (GE20) with 20 tuition hours per week and the General English Fluency Plus course (GE26) with 26 tuition hours per week are language rich courses that help teachers upgrade their level of English for every day communication. Our teaching is based on a communicative approach, which means students always focus on effective real-life communication, exchanging ideas, opinions and experiences. Each day there are two lessons:

• Lesson A: 9.00am to 10.40am

Lesson B: 11.00am to 12.50pm

Lessons A and B are taught by different teachers to give the learners exposure to a variety of accents and teaching styles. The GE26 course offers 5 additional hours of classes in the afternoons (small group tuition). During the course there are also links to continued learning in a more informal environment outside the classroom in this diverse city of Dublin.
